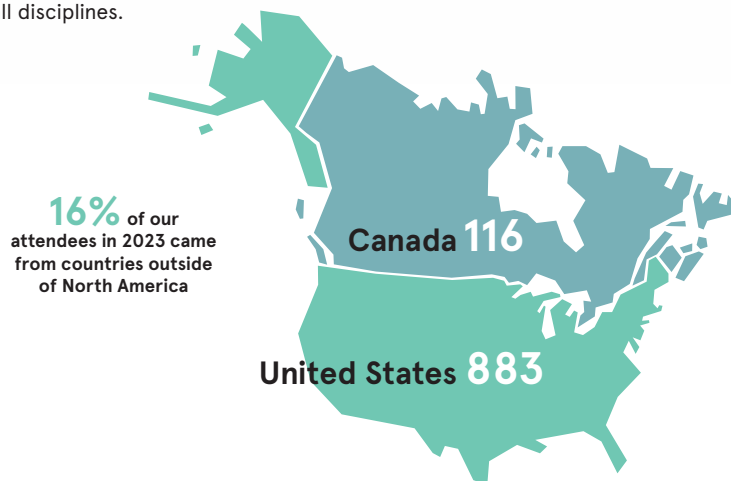

The AACPDMD Annual Meeting is an international forum for the dissemination and exchange of new knowledge, ideas and educational information between participants from all disciplines.



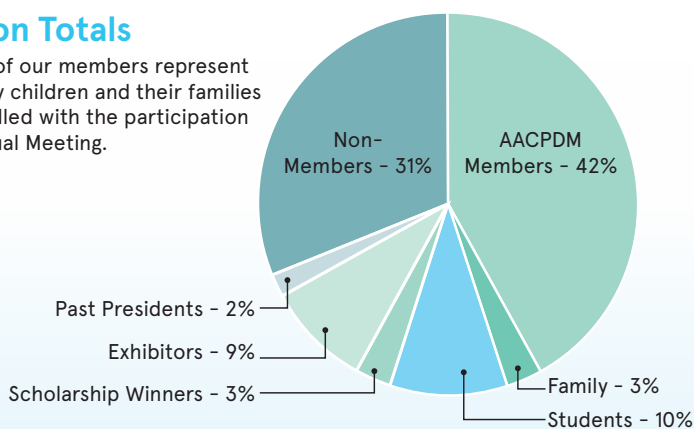
## 2023 Annual Meeting Attendance by Specialty Fields
